# Registration Issues

- **Dates**
  - First two weeks of term
  - Registration is on a first-come-first-served basis
- **Foundation and Elective courses**
  - Advisable to take Foundation courses first if possible, but not mandatory
    - Not fulfilling Foundation requirements will prevent you from graduating
  - Most courses do not have prerequisites but check with instructors if in doubt



# Registration Issues

- **Some classes are full**
  - Not being able to register for some classes happens every semester
  - As registration is done on a first-come-first-served basis, students who are slower will be left out
  - Some students over-register for courses and will drop courses in the second week of the add/drop period

# Registration Issues

- What do you do?
  - Don't panic!
  - Don't hound the course instructor
  - Take other courses (within or cross-program)
  - Constantly monitor the class sizes on GSLink
  - Attend classes during add/drop even if not registered yet as vacancies may open up
  - Carefully plan your time-table
  - Don't over-register for courses
