

## **HWG702 Small Group Teaching (Applicable to full-time PhD students)**

HWG702 is a teaching course that aims to equip graduate students with knowledge and skills necessary for effective small group teaching.

All full-time PhD Students are required to attend and pass the course HWG702 Small Group Teaching. Students who fail the course will have to repeat it until they pass. The course will appear in the transcript but will not be included in the GPA computation.

HWG702 is administered by the Centre for Excellence in Learning & Teaching (CELT).

PhD students who did not fulfill **HWG702** can still continue their candidature without teaching responsibilities. They may proceed with the confirmation of candidature without the S\$500 stipend increment until they pass HWG702. **There will be no backdating of stipend increment for these candidates when they subsequently pass HWG702.** Students who fulfill the HWG702 course can continue their candidature with teaching responsibilities. They will receive the S\$500 increment in RSS monthly stipend upon confirmation with teaching responsibilities.

Note: Students must pass HWG703 (unless exempted) before they are allowed to take HWG702. As such, students cannot take both HWG703 and HWG702 in the same semester.
